About Our Ministry

S.A.L.A.M. in the Holy Land

is a ministry dedicated to serving among local Arab Christians in Israel and Palestine, training individuals for interaction with Arabic speaking people (particularly those from Muslim backgrounds) and committed to raising awareness about Arab Christians.

Today, the Holy Land is holy in name only. Less than 2% of its diverse population are Christian and of that number only 2% are evangelical. Part of our vision of reclaiming the Holy Land for Christ is to encourage a heart for ministry among the many visitors who flock there each year. We hope to see Christian visitors supporting the Body of Christ in the Holy Land as ministers and not merely tourists.

Salam is the Arabic word for “peace” and represents our ultimate goal: to spread the gospel among non-believing Arabs and Jews in Israel and Palestine so that many may know the true peace of Jesus Christ.

Who Are The Arab Christians?

Arab Christians in the Holy Land are native believers of Jesus and can trace their conversion roots back to the time of Christ. They represent a small minority of the Israeli and Palestinian populations, less than 2%. Most of these Arab Christians belong to the Roman Catholic and Greek Orthodox churches.
